




Evaluation Results Showed...

of respondents agreed (88%) or somewhat agreed (12%) that the Forum expanded collective understanding of mental health promotion.

100% of respondents agreed (77%) or somewhat agreed (23%) that the Forum was successful in advancing momentum for a whole society approach to mental health promotion.

98% of respondents agreed (72%) or somewhat agreed (26%) that they developed networks for future collaboration.

89% of respondents agreed (77%) or somewhat agreed (12%) that they developed new knowledge and skills that can be applied to their work in their organization and community.

100% of respondents agreed (88%) or somewhat agreed (12%) that they would recommend ASI events to others.
